Work-Based Learning Grant (SUNY)

- Complete and sign the "Five Hallmarks of Quality Work-Based Learning Programs
- Selected employees must complete release forms and provide personal information

Customized Corporate Training Grant (SUNY)

- Provide a letter of support
- Provide at least 10-25% cash match
- Provide information on participants
